It is up to the Day Camp Den Leaders in attendance to approve the portions or the whole of each Adventure and to sign the Cub Scouts' rank book. In general, it is the Day Camp Den Leaders who have the final say on whether the Scout did his 'best' and completed the requirements.

Salmon Run: #9 (if earned 'beginner' swim classification)

(Webelos-entering 4th grade in fall of 2019)

(Arrow of Light-entering 5th grade in fall of 2019)

To be completed at home: #2 - Visit a museum, a college, a laboratory, an observatory, a zoo, an aquarium, or other facility that employs scientists. Prepare three (3) questions ahead of time and talk to a scientist about his or her work.
